I am known and appreciated in the academic world mainly because of these Main Areas of Research and Major Scientific Achievements:

- **Bartolomé de Las Casas (Mission, Colonialism and Human Dignity):** five-volume edition of the writings of Bartolomé de Las Casas; one volume on the life and work of Bartolomé de Las Casas (German, English, French).
- **Global Christianity in the last 500 years:** two volumes of source texts on Christianity in Latin America; two volumes on the church and religious history of Latin America; one volume on the church history of the Philippines; one volume on transformations and perspectives of global Christianity.
- **Mysticism:** three volumes on the mystics' criticism of the Church; one volume on Teresa of Avila; one volume on Miguel de Molinos; one volume on women's mysticism; one volume on the diversity of mystical experience.
- **History of theology in the 20th century:** a volume on the Christianity of theologians in the 20th century; two volumes on the theology of liberation; two volumes on German-language theology in the 20th century.
- **Second Vatican Council:** one volume on Swiss theologians and the Second Vatican Council; one volume on the reception of the Council.
- **Interreligious dialogue:** two volumes on interreligious dialogue from a Christian perspective; one volume on interreligious dialogue in the tradition of the Order of Preachers.
- **Missiology:** three volumes on missionary history and theology in transition, one volume on missionary spirituality; editorship of the renowned Zeitschrift für Missionswissenschaft und Religionswissenschaft (from 2001-2023).
- **History and Theology of the School of Salamanca:** a volume on religion and culture in Spain's Golden Age (in German and Spanish).
- **Christian Religious and Cultural History:** 20 volumes with different focal points.
- **European Religious and Cultural History:** one volume on Europe as a cultural challenge; a volume on the reception of the Book of Daniel in Europe's History; one volume on Islam in Europe; one volume on Europe as a Christian project; one volume on the spiritual roots of Europe.
- **Tolerance research:** two volumes on tolerance in history and the present day.

I have been present in the media on all these topics (podcasts, videos, interviews, press articles, also in online portals)

In addition, I have conceived and edited many anthologies on these focal points, but also on other topics (see Publication list with more than a thousand titles), and have written many academic articles.
